BURNING PERMIT RULES

Pursuant to this by law every person obtaining a burn permit for setting, permitting to be set, maintaining, or permitting to be maintained, an Open Air Fire shall comply with the following conditions:

- a) the material is burned in a single pile that is less than three (3) metres in diameter and less than three (3) metres high,
- b) burn only wood or by-products of wood,
- c) not burn noxious material,
- d) ensure that the fire is a safe distance away from property lines, buildings, fences, trees and roadways,
- e) ensure that the means of extinguishing the fire, designated in the burn permit, is available at the site, at all times during the fire,
- f) ensure a responsible person is available and in attendance at all times until the fire is <u>completely</u> extinguished,
- g) will abide by the conditions of Township of Algonquin Highlands Bylaw 2019-31,
- h) will be subject to charges for fire department response, for any contraventions of By-law 2019-31.
